

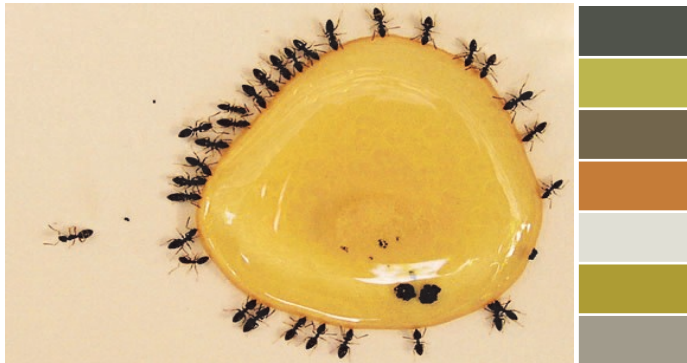
# Rise Your Self to Help Mankind

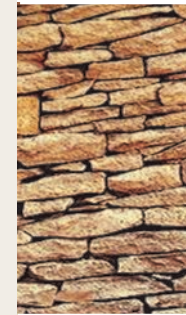

## Rise Your Self to Help Mankind

To develop a social work community involving all social areas, to shift from the notion of providing care to the principle of promoting social development, Conflict Resolution, the alleviation of knowledge, disadvantaged, deprived and those affected by the lack of advance studying progress and helping Somali Diaspora and Refugees.

### NAME AND PURPOSE >>>

1. Name of association is Somali Social Affairs in Denmark, or as acronym SSAD.
  2. Headquarters of the Association is in Copenhagen.
  3. Aims and Objectives of the Association are as follows:
    - a. To unite and bring together Somalis living in Denmark without prejudice to their beliefs and religions, political affiliations or tribal origins.
- To give preference important issues pertaining to our national development in various aspects

including education, health, entrepreneurship, tourism, social welfare, etc.

### MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS >>>

Any person is allowed to be SSAD member given he or she satisfies the following conditions:

1. Being citizen of the United Republic of Somalia with age not below 16 years. Being citizen should be taken to mean:
  - a. Somali citizen by virtue of birth (native)

b. Somali through naturalization through legal immigration process.  
c. Having paid membership entry fees.

a. Having paid annual membership contribution  
c. Having paid any other contributions as agreed upon by SSAD.

2. Any person being a non-citizen of Somali Democratic Republic may be allowed to be SSAD member if she or he satisfies any of the following conditions:

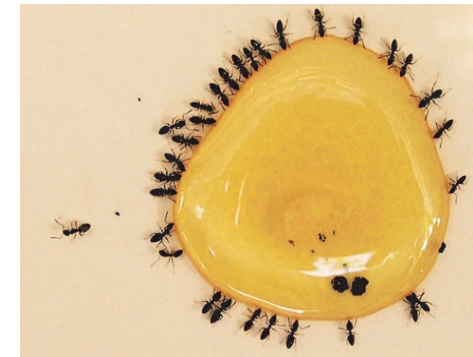
a. She or he is a former citizen of the Somali Democratic Republic and now has another citizenship.

b. She or he is a biological child of a citizen or former citizen of the Somali Democratic Republic.

c. She is in a marital bond with a citizen or former citizen of the Somali Democratic Republic.

d. Having paid membership entry fees.

e. Having paid annual membership contribution  
Having paid any other contributions as agreed upon by SSAD.
